Armed with all the emails and comments John Thatcher, Adrian Thomas and I went to Mill Rythe Holiday Village to meet once again with IOW Tours Ltd.

Taking time away from work we could only stay the one night but spent two full days having a good look around.

We tried the food, timed the service, slept in recently refurbished chalets, measured the areas designated to become terrains, discussed all your concerns and even found some time for a beer and a couple of frames of snooker!

The apartments/chalets were very clean and a tour of them showed us that it was not just the ones we were staying in that were like that.

The staff on site were polite, always to hand and very willing to help and there is no doubt that IOW Tours Managing Director, Shirley Winn and Sales Manager Geoff Holt are very keen to work with the EPA Management Committee to ensure we have a successful competition at this new venue.

The site director confirmed they would build a terrain of over 50 lanes which, added to the main car park, would give us plenty of room to play.

With loW Tours Ltd help we have looked at a variety of venues and we have considered staying with Pontins at Brean, yet despite some very promising venues we came to the conclusion that the best option for our members and prestigious event is Mill Rythe Holiday Village.

So the decision has been made and contracts signed, our Inter-Regional Championship & Challenge Tournament will be held at Mill Rythe Holiday Village on the 17th and 18th September 2012.

Brochures and booking forms for accommodation will be issued in the new year by our new partners Isle of Wight Tours Ltd.
